## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, providing for personal reproductive liberty.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby resolves as follows:
- 5 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
- 6 Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI:
- 7 That Article I be amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 30. Personal reproductive liberty.
- 9 Every individual has the fundamental right to exercise
- 10 personal reproductive liberty and make and effectuate decisions
- 11 regarding the individual's own reproduction, including the
- 12 <u>ability to choose or refuse to prevent, continue or end the</u>
- 13 individual's pregnancy, the right to choose or refuse
- 14 contraceptives and the right to choose or refuse fertility care,
- 15 all without discrimination on the basis of race, age,
- 16 <u>disability</u>, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, religion
- 17 or relationship status. The Commonwealth may not deny, burden,

- 1 <u>infringe upon or abridge this right unless justified by a</u>
- 2 compelling State interest achieved by the least restrictive
- 3 means.
- 4 Section 2. The following procedure applies to the proposed
- 5 constitutional amendment in this joint resolution:
- 6 (1) Upon the first passage by the General Assembly of
- 7 the amendment, the Secretary of the Commonwealth shall
- 8 proceed immediately to comply with the advertising
- 9 requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the Constitution
- of Pennsylvania.
- 11 (2) Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of
- the amendment, the Secretary of the Commonwealth shall
- proceed immediately to comply with the advertising
- requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the Constitution
- of Pennsylvania. The Secretary of the Commonwealth shall
- submit the amendment to the qualified electors of this
- 17 Commonwealth at the first general or municipal election which
- meets the requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the
- 19 Constitution of Pennsylvania.
