AN ACT

1 Amending Title 66 (Public Utilities) of the Pennsylvania  
2 Consolidated Statutes, in transportation network service,  
3 further providing for transportation network company drivers.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 2605 of Title 66 of the Pennsylvania  
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding subsections to read:

8 § 2605. Transportation network company drivers.

10 (d) Proper driver credentials.--A driver for a  
11 transportation network company serving customers in this  
12 Commonwealth shall be provided a barcode or machine-readable  
13 code by the transportation network company that is unique to  
14 that driver, which shall be displayed on that driver's vehicle  
15 in a manner visible and verifiable prior to entry of the vehicle  
16 by any customer. The code shall link to the driver's credentials  
17 on a publicly accessible Internet website hosted by the  
18 transportation network company.

1     (e) Offense.--Any individual who falsely represents  
2 themselves as a transportation network company's driver or fails  
3 to present the credentials provided for under subsection (d)  
4 shall be guilty of a misdemeanor of the second degree. Any  
5 individual who falsely represents themselves as a transportation  
6 network company's driver or fails to present the credentials  
7 provided for under subsection (d), which results in harm to an  
8 individual, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor of the first  
9 degree.

10     Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
