AN ACT

Amending the act of August 26, 1971 (P.L.351, No.91), entitled 2 "An act providing for a State Lottery and administration 3 thereof; authorizing the creation of a State Lottery Commission; prescribing its powers and duties; disposition of 5 funds; violations and penalties therefor; exemption of prizes from State and local taxation and making an appropriation," 6 7 prohibiting the awarding of certain prizes. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. The act of August 26, 1971 (P.L.351, No.91), 10 11 known as the State Lottery Law, is amended by adding a section 12 to read: 13 Section 10.1. Award of Certain Prizes Prohibited. -- No prize 14 shall be awarded unless it shall have been produced or 15 manufactured within the United States, inclusive of all territory, continental or insular, subject to the jurisdiction 16 of the United States. In acquiring prizes for distribution 17

pursuant to this act, the secretary shall, whenever feasible,
