## AN ACT

Amending Title 23 (Domestic Relations) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in child protective services, further 2 providing for definitions and for information relating to 3 4 family day-care home residents. 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Section 6303(a) of Title 23 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a definition to read: \$ 6303. Definitions. 9 10 General rule. -- The following words and phrases when used 11 in this chapter shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the context clearly indicates otherwise: 12 \* \* \* 13 14 "Relative/neighbor care." Child care provided by an 15 individual who cares for three or fewer children unrelated to 16 the individual in the individual's home. 17 \* \* \* Section 2. Section 6344.1(a) and (c) of Title 23 are amended 18

- 3 (a) General rule. -- In addition to the requirements of
- 4 section 6344 (relating to information relating to prospective
- 5 child-care personnel), an individual who applies to the
- 6 department for a registration certificate to operate a family
- 7 day-care home or to provide relative/neighbor care shall include
- 8 criminal history record and child abuse record information
- 9 required under section 6344(b) for every individual 18 years of
- 10 age or older who resides in the home for at least 30 days in a
- 11 calendar year.

- 13 (c) Effect on registration. -- The department shall refuse to
- 14 issue or renew a registration certificate or shall revoke a
- 15 registration certificate if the family day-care home provider or
- 16 <u>relative/neighbor care provider</u> or individual 18 years of age or
- 17 older who has resided in the home for at least 30 days in a
- 18 calendar year:
- 19 (1) is named in the central register on child abuse
- 20 established under Chapter 63 (relating to child protective
- 21 services) as the perpetrator of a founded report committed
- 22 within the immediately preceding five-year period; or
- 23 (2) has been convicted of an offense enumerated in
- 24 section 6344(c).

- 26 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
