AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain 3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto, " prohibiting school administrators from changing the grade of proficiency given to any pupil 7 unless such change is approved by the teacher giving such 8 grade. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 10 hereby enacts as follows: 11 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the "Public School Code of 1949," is amended by adding a 12 13 section to read: 14 Section 1531.1. Grade Changes. -- No school administrator shall change the grade of proficiency given to any pupil for any 15
- 16 course unless such change shall have been approved in writing by
- 17 the teacher giving such grade.
- 18 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
