## HOUSE BILL No. 2154 Session of 1980

INTRODUCED BY PITTS, RAPPAPORT, ROCKS, HOEFFEL, MICOZZIE, NAHILL AND WHITE, JANUARY 22, 1980

REFERRED TO COMMITTEE ON TRANSPORTATION, JANUARY 22, 1980

## AN ACT

Amending the act of July 20, 1968 (P.L.550, No.217), entitled "An act implementing the provisions of clause (4) of subsection (a) of section 7 of Article VIII of the 3 Constitution of Pennsylvania authorizing and restricting the 5 incurring of certain debt; providing for a capital budget bill; imposing duties upon the Governor, the Auditor General 7 and the State Treasurer; prescribing procedures for the 8 issuance, sale and payment of certain general obligation 9 bonds, the disposition of the proceeds therefrom, and the funding of debt and refunding of bonds; exempting said bonds 10 from State and local taxation; creating certain funds; and 11 providing for certain appropriations," further providing for 12 13 transportation assistance projects and providing for a 14 transportation assistance capital budget bill and debt authorizing legislation. 15 16 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 17 hereby enacts as follows: 18 Section 1. The definition of "Transportation Assistance 19 Projects" in clause (1) of section 2, act of July 20, 1968 20 (P.L.550, No.217), known as the "Capital Facilities Debt 21 Enabling Act, amended July 9, 1976 (P.L.967, No.190), is 22 amended to read: 23 Section 2. Definitions. -- As used in this act--24 (1)

- 1 "Transportation Assistance Projects," means and includes
- 2 [projects of a type which the Pennsylvania Transportation
- 3 Assistance Authority is authorized to construct, improve, equip,
- 4 furnish, maintain, acquire, or operate under the provisions of
- 5 the act of January 22, 1968 (P.L.27, No.7), known as "The
- 6 Pennsylvania Transportation Assistance Authority Act of 1967,"]
- 7 <u>capital projects which the Department of Transportation is</u>
- 8 authorized to construct, improve, equip, furnish, maintain,
- 9 acquire or operate under the provisions of the act of January
- 10 22, 1968 (P.L.42, No.8), known as the "Pennsylvania Urban Mass
- 11 <u>Transportation Assistance Law of 1967,"</u> and also capital
- 12 projects which the Department of Transportation is authorized to
- 13 construct, improve, equip or furnish, under the provisions of
- 14 the act of February 11, 1976 (P.L.14, No.10), known as the
- 15 "Pennsylvania Rural and Intercity Common Carrier Surface
- 16 Transportation Assistance Act," including the acquisition of
- 17 property therein authorized.
- 18 \* \* \*
- 19 Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read:
- 20 Section 3.1. Procedures for Transportation Assistance
- 21 Capital Budget Bill and Debt Authorizing Legislation. (a) A
- 22 transportation assistance capital budget prepared in accordance
- 23 with this act shall be submitted each fiscal year by the
- 24 Governor to the General Assembly in the form of a bill and shall
- 25 thereafter proceed to consideration as provided in Article III
- 26 of the Constitution of Pennsylvania.
- 27 (b) Each local transportation organization and
- 28 transportation company shall submit annually to the Department
- 29 of Transportation between September 15 and October 15 a proposed
- 30 six-year capital program for the fiscal year beginning July 1

- 1 and for the next succeeding five fiscal years. The proposed six-
- 2 year capital program shall be specifically itemized by brief
- 3 identifying description and estimated financial cost. The fiscal
- 4 year beginning July 1 and the following three fiscal years shall
- 5 be the budget years and the next two fiscal years shall be the
- 6 <u>budget projection years</u>.
- 7 (c) The transportation assistance capital budget shall
- 8 specifically itemize by brief identifying description and
- 9 <u>estimated financial cost, the transportation assistance capital</u>
- 10 projects to be financed from general revenue appropriations or
- 11 <u>from the proceeds of obligations of the Commonwealth for each of</u>
- 12 the four budget years except where such itemization is contained
- 13 <u>in or approved by prior legislation referred to in the</u>
- 14 transportation assistance capital budget bill or except where
- 15 <u>such itemization is included in one or more supplemental</u>
- 16 transportation assistance capital budget bills. Such projects
- 17 shall be listed in separate categories, as well as according to
- 18 the fund to be charged with the repayment of the obligations to
- 19 be incurred. The transportation assistance capital budget bill
- 20 shall state the maximum amount of such obligations which may be
- 21 incurred in each of the four ensuing fiscal years to provide
- 22 funds for and toward the financial costs of each category of
- 23 transportation assistance capital projects, which shall be by
- 24 the issue of general obligations of the Commonwealth.
- 25 (d) On or before March 1, 1981 and in each succeeding year,
- 26 the Governor shall submit to the General Assembly the proposed
- 27 six-year capital programs of each of the several local
- 28 transportation organizations and transportation companies
- 29 together with the recommendations of approval or disapproval by
- 30 the Department of Transportation and a transportation assistance

- 1 capital budget bill for the ensuing four fiscal years. Each
- 2 local transportation organization or transportation company
- 3 shall be prepared to appear before the General Assembly to
- 4 justify its proposed six-year capital program.
- 5 (e) At the time the Governor submits the transportation
- 6 <u>assistance capital budget bill, or a supplement thereto as</u>
- 7 aforesaid, he shall, to the extent the debt to be incurred is
- 8 not within the limits of the legislation then in force
- 9 authorizing the expenditure of appropriated funds or the
- 10 incurring of debt, submit additional bills for each category of
- 11 transportation assistance capital projects, authorizing the
- 12 appropriation of general revenues or the incurring of debt to
- 13 provide funds for and toward the payment of the financial costs
- 14 of transportation assistance capital projects in such category
- 15 which have been specifically itemized in a transportation
- 16 assistance capital budget for the same or any prior year.
- 17 (f) Each debt authorizing bill shall state the category of
- 18 transportation assistance capital projects to be financed by the
- 19 debt so authorized, but need not enumerate the capital projects
- 20 to be financed, shall authorize the fiscal year in which the
- 21 <u>debt is to be incurred, shall authorize the incurring of debt in</u>
- 22 not less than the amount of financial cost of all transportation
- 23 assistance capital projects in such category not covered by a
- 24 previous debt authorization or general revenue appropriation,
- 25 <u>including any allowance for contingencies, shall state the</u>
- 26 <u>estimated useful lives of the transportation assistance capital</u>
- 27 projects to be financed in such detail as may be required where
- 28 <u>transportation assistance projects of varying useful lives are</u>
- 29 to be combined for financing purposes, and shall state the
- 30 maximum term of the debt to be incurred.

- 1 Section 3. Subsection (a) of section 10 of the act, amended
- 2 July 24, 1969 (P.L.183, No.75), is amended to read:
- 3 Section 10. Disposition and Use of Proceeds.--(a) The
- 4 proceeds of all general revenue appropriations made pursuant to
- 5 the provisions of section 3.1 of this act, the proceeds of all
- 6 temporary borrowings made pursuant to the provisions of section
- 7 6 of this act, and the proceeds from the sale of bonds, other
- 8 than funding bonds, issued pursuant to the provisions of section
- 9 7 of this act, shall be paid to the State Treasurer and be held
- 10 by him in a separate fund and, shall be deposited in such
- 11 depositories as may be selected by him to the credit of such
- 12 fund, which fund shall be known as the "Capital Facilities
- 13 Fund," which shall have such separate accounts therein as may be
- 14 deemed desirable by the issuing officials, but not less than one
- 15 separate account for each category of capital projects.
