AN ACT

Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the 1 2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for 3 court divisions. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 4 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Section 951 of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read: § 951. Court divisions. 9 (c.1) Other separate family court divisions. -- Judicial 10 11 districts comprised of seven 15 or more judges shall have separate family court divisions. The family court division shall 12 have jurisdiction over all sections relating to: 13 14 (1) Adoption. 15 (2) Divorce.

(3) Support, ALIMONY, marital property and MARITAL
