1 2 3	Amending Title 34 (Game) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in hunting and furtaking licenses, further providing for classes of licenses.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Section 2705(1), (2), (4), (5), (7.1), (8), (9),
7	(10), (11) and (11.1) of Title 34 of the Pennsylvania
8	Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:
9	§ 2705. Classes of licenses.
10	Unless otherwise provided, any person wishing to exercise any
11	of the privileges granted by this title shall first secure the
12	applicable resident or nonresident hunting or furtaker license
13	as follows:
14	(1) Adult resident hunting licenses to residents who
15	have reached their [17th] <u>22nd</u> birthday but have not reached
16	their 65th birthday.
17	(2) Junior resident hunting licenses to residents who
18	have reached or will reach their 12th birthday in the license

1 year of application for a license but who have not reached 2 their 17th birthday prior to the date of the application for the license and who, if 16 years of age or younger, present a 3 written request, bearing the signature of a parent or 4 5 quardian, for the issuance of a license. The actual hunting 6 privileges granted to the holder of a junior license shall 7 not be exercised until that person in fact is 12 years of 8 age.

10 (4) Adult resident furtaker licenses to residents who 11 have reached their [17th] <u>22nd</u> birthday but have not reached 12 their 65th birthday.

Junior resident furtaker licenses to residents who 13 (5)14 have reached or will reach their 12th birthday in the license year of application for a license but who have not reached 15 16 their 17th birthday prior to the date of the application for 17 the license and who, if 16 years of age or younger, present a 18 written request, containing the signature of a parent or 19 quardian, for the issuance of a license. The actual furtaking 20 privileges granted to the holder of a junior license shall 21 not be exercised until that person in fact is 12 years of 22 age.

license, including archery and muzzleloader privileges, to
residents who have reached or will reach their 12th birthday
in the license year of application for a license but who have
not reached their 17th birthday prior to the date of the
application for the license and who, if 16 years of age or
younger, present a written request, containing the signature

1 of a parent or guardian, for the issuance of a license. The 2 actual privileges granted to the holder of a junior resident 3 combination license shall not be exercised until that person 4 in fact is 12 years of age.

5 (8) Adult nonresident hunting licenses to all
6 nonresidents of [17] <u>22</u> years of age or older.

7 Junior nonresident hunting licenses to all (9) 8 nonresidents who have reached or will reach their 12th 9 birthday in the license year of application for a license but 10 who have not reached their 17th birthday prior to the date of 11 the application for the license and who, if 16 years of age 12 or younger, present a written request, bearing the signature 13 of a parent or quardian, for the issuance of a license. The 14 actual hunting privileges granted to the holder of a junior 15 license shall not be exercised until that person in fact is 16 12 years of age.

17 (10) Adult nonresident furtaker licenses to nonresidents
18 of [17] <u>22</u> years of age or older.

19 (11)Junior nonresident furtaker licenses to 20 nonresidents who have reached or will reach their 12th 21 birthday in the license year of application for a license but 22 who have not reached their 17th birthday prior to the date of 23 the application for the license and who, if 16 years of age 24 or younger, present a written request, containing the 25 signature of a parent or guardian, for the issuance of a 26 license. The actual furtaking privileges granted to the 27 holder of a junior license shall not be exercised until that person in fact is 12 years of age. 28

 furtaker license, including archery and muzzleloader

1 privileges, to nonresidents who have reached or will reach 2 their 12th birthday in the license year of application for a license but who have not reached their 17th birthday prior to 3 the date of the application for the license and who, if 16 4 years of age or younger, present a written request, 5 containing the signature of a parent or guardian, for the 6 issuance of a license. The actual privileges granted to the 7 holder of a junior nonresident combination license shall not 8 9 be exercised until that person in fact is 12 years of age. * * * 10

11 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
