AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
- act relating to the public school system, including certain
- provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- laws relating thereto," in certification of teachers,
- 6 providing for out-of-State applicants for career and
- 7 technical education certification.
- 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 9 hereby enacts as follows:
- 10 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- 11 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
- 12 section to read:
- 13 Section 1204.3. Out-of-State Applicants for Career and
- 14 Technical Education Certification. -- (a) The Department of
- 15 Education shall issue a comparable Career and Technical
- 16 <u>Instructional I Certificate to an out-of-State candidate who</u>
- 17 <u>satisfies the following:</u>
- 18 (1) The candidate holds a valid and current career and
- 19 <u>technical instructional certificate or equivalent certificate</u>

- 1 issued by another state.
- 2 (2) The candidate has completed a minimum of four (4) years
- 3 wage-earning experience in the occupation to be taught.
- 4 (3) The candidate HAS AT LEAST TWO (2) YEARS OF CLASSROOM <--
- 5 TEACHING EXPERIENCE AND provides evidence of satisfactory
- 6 professional educator experience PERFORMANCE for the candidate's <--
- 7 two (2) most recent years of classroom teaching.
- 8 (4) The candidate meets all requirements in 22 Pa Code §
- 9 <u>49.12 (relating to eligibility).</u>
- 10 (b) A Career and Technical Instructional I Certificate
- 11 issued under subsection (a) shall be valid for eight (8) annual
- 12 school terms and shall be converted to a Career and Technical
- 13 <u>Instructional II Certificate in accordance with 22 Pa. Code §</u>
- 14 49.143 (relating to Vocational Instructional II).
- 15 (c) An out-of-State candidate who is seeking a Career and
- 16 <u>Technical Instructional I Certificate and meets the requirements</u>
- 17 of subsection (a) shall be issued a Career and Technical
- 18 Instructional I Certificate on an expedited basis in accordance
- 19 with this section.
- 20 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
