| (a) IntentIt is the intent of the General Assembly that |
| it is against public policy for an employer to terminate an |
| employee solely because the employee filed a valid claim for |
| workers' compensation. |
| (b) Cause of actionAn action may be brought by a person |
| against a former employer of that person for damages resulting |
| from the employer's discharge of that person solely because that |
| person filed a valid claim for workers' compensation. |
| Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately. |
