A RESOLUTION

- 1 Declaring that May 8 through 14, 2005, be observed as "National Nursing Home Week" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Skilled nursing facilities throughout the nation are
- 4 observing "National Nursing Home Week"; and
- 5 WHEREAS, The dedicated professionals who work in nursing
- 6 homes provide critical services in the continuum of long-term
- 7 care for many citizens of this Commonwealth; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania has more than 1.9 million people over
- 9 65 years of age, representing approximately 16% of this
- 10 Commonwealth's population; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania is the third oldest state in the nation
- 12 by percentage of those 65 years of age and older; and
- WHEREAS, There are 82,000 frail, elderly and disabled
- 14 Pennsylvanians residing in this Commonwealth's 732 nursing
- 15 homes; and
- 16 WHEREAS, It is appropriate that nursing homes in this

- 1 Commonwealth join the nation to observe "National Nursing Home
- 2 Week"; therefore be it
- 3 RESOLVED, That the Senate declare that May 8 through 14,
- 4 2005, be observed as "National Nursing Home Week" in
