Amending the act of April 27, 1927 (P.L.465, No.299), entitled "An act to provide for the safety of persons employed, housed, or assembled in certain buildings and structures by 3 requiring certain construction and ways of egress, equipment, 4 and maintenance; providing for the licensing of 5 projectionists, except in cities of the first class and 6 7 second class; requiring the submission of plans for examination and approval; providing for the promulgation of rules and regulations for the enforcement of this act; 8 9 providing for the enforcement of this act by the Department 10 11 of Labor and Industry, the Department of Health, boards of school directors and, in certain cases, by the chiefs of fire 12 departments in cities of the third class; providing penalties 13 for violations of the provisions of this act; and repealing 14 certain acts," further providing for standards for Class VI 15 buildings. 16 17 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 18 hereby enacts as follows: 19 Section 1.
