- 11 WHEREAS, The National Red Ribbon Campaign will be celebrated
- 12 in every community in the United States during "Red Ribbon
- 13 Week," October 23 through 31, 2015; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Businesses, government officials and employees, law
- 15 enforcement agencies, media outlets, medical institutions,
- 16 religious institutions, schools, senior citizen organizations,
- 17 service organizations and youth organizations will demonstrate

- 4 and activities to promote substance abuse prevention efforts;
