Commonwealth portion of fines, etc. * * * 10 11 (b) Vehicle offenses.--* * * 12 13 (2) (i) Except as provided in [paragraph (4)] 14 paragraphs (4) and (5), when prosecution under any other 15 provision of Title 75 (relating to vehicles) is the result of State Police action, all fines, forfeited 16 17 EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN [PARAGRAPH (4)] PARAGRAPHS (4) 18 AND (5), WHEN PROSECUTION UNDER ANY OTHER PROVISION OF TITLE
