## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing December 10, 2015, as "International Human Rights Day" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, The Universal Declaration of Human Rights was
- 4 adopted by the United Nations General Assembly on December 10,
- 5 1948, in order to sufficiently define the rights referenced in
- 6 the United Nations Charter; and
- 7 WHEREAS, As chair of the United Nations Commission on Human
- 8 Rights, First Lady Eleanor Roosevelt was instrumental in the
- 9 drafting process of the declaration; and
- 10 WHEREAS, The Preamble of the Declaration proclaims,
- 11 "Disregard and contempt for human rights have resulted in
- 12 barbarous acts which have outraged the conscience of mankind,
- 13 and the advent of a world in which human beings shall enjoy
- 14 freedom of speech and belief and freedom from fear and want has
- 15 been proclaimed as the highest aspiration of the common people";
- 16 and
- 17 WHEREAS, The Universal Declaration of Human Rights has been
- 18 referred to as "the international Magna Carta for all mankind"

- 1 due to its intent to clarify the rights of all human beings; and
- 2 WHEREAS, Each year, December 10th is observed by individuals,
- 3 communities, religious groups, human rights organizations,
- 4 governments and the United Nations as a day to promote human
- 5 rights awareness throughout the world; and
- 6 WHEREAS, December 10, 2015, marks the 67th anniversary of the
- 7 United Nations General Assembly adopting the Universal
- 8 Declaration of Human Rights; therefore be it
- 9 RESOLVED, That the Senate recognize December 10, 2015, as
- 10 "International Human Rights Day" in Pennsylvania.
