- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, further providing for the display of registration
- 3 plates.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 1332 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 1332. Display of registration plate.
- 9 (a) General rule. -- Every registration plate shall, at all
- 10 times, be securely fastened in duplicate fashion to the front
- 11 and rear of the vehicle to which it is assigned or on which its
- 12 use is authorized in accordance with regulations promulgated by
- 13 the department.
- 14 (b) Obscuring plate. -- It is unlawful to display on any
- 15 vehicle a registration plate which is so dirty as to prevent the
- 16 reading of the number or letters thereon at a reasonable
- 17 distance or is otherwise illegible at a reasonable distance or
- 18 is obscured in any manner.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect January 1, 2005.
