AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, further providing for the display of registration
3 plates.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 1332 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

8 § 1332. Display of registration plate.

9 (a) General rule.--Every registration plate shall, at all
10 times, be securely fastened in duplicate fashion to the front
11 and rear of the vehicle to which it is assigned or on which its
12 use is authorized in accordance with regulations promulgated by
13 the department.

14 (b) Obscuring plate.--It is unlawful to display on any
15 vehicle a registration plate which is so dirty as to prevent the
16 reading of the number or letters thereon at a reasonable
17 distance or is otherwise illegible at a reasonable distance or
18 is obscured in any manner.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect January 1, 2005.
