A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring Pennsylvania's senior citizens by declaring the month
2 of May 2006 as "Older Americans Month" in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, For more than 40 years, the President of the United
4 States has designated the month of May as "Older Americans
5 Month"; and

6 WHEREAS, Senior citizens are the pillars upon which American
7 families have been built; and

8 WHEREAS, "Older Americans Month" is celebrated throughout our
9 nation with seminars, festivals, fairs and other activities
10 which highlight the interests and accomplishments of our
11 nation's senior citizens; and

12 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania proudly ranks second in the nation in
13 the percentage of population which is 65 years of age and older;

15 WHEREAS, The heritage of this Commonwealth is embodied in and
16 enriched by the senior citizens who, as part of the American

1 family, call Pennsylvania home; and

2 WHEREAS, Senior citizens strengthen and preserve community in
3 our State and nation; therefore be it

4 RESOLVED, That the Senate honor Pennsylvania's senior
5 citizens by declaring May 2006 as "Older Americans Month" in
6 Pennsylvania.
