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AN ACT

Amending the act of December 19, 1990 (P.L.1234, No.204), 2 entitled "An act establishing a program to assist persons who 3 bear primary responsibility for the at-home care of functionally dependent older adults and victims of chronic dementia, " further providing for reimbursement. 5 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 8 Section 5(b) of the act of December 19, 1990 (P.L.1234, No.204), known as the Family Caregiver Support Act, 10 is amended to read: 11 Section 5. Reimbursements. 12 13 (b) Maximum amounts.--14 The maximum amount available to a qualified caregiver whose household income is under 200% of poverty 15 16 level shall be established by regulation, but shall not

exceed [\$200] \$500 per month, for out-of-pocket expenses

incurred for services described in section 4(c)(2).
