## AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain
- provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- laws relating thereto," in terms and courses of study,
- further providing for physical education.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. Section 1512.1 of the act of March 10, 1949
- 10 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is
- 11 amended to read:
- 12 Section 1512.1. Physical Education. -- (a) The board of
- 13 school directors in every school district shall establish a
- 14 curriculum aligned with Pennsylvania academic standards on
- 15 health, safety and physical education that pursuant to 22 Pa.
- 16 Code § 4.27 (relating to physical education and athletics),
- 17 requires pupils enrolled in the district to participate in
- 18 physical education.
- 19 (b) The board of school directors shall permit students to
- 20 <u>satisfy the physical education curriculum requirement under</u>

- 1 <u>subsection (a) by participation in an interscholastic sport. A</u>
- 2 student may utilize participation in an interscholastic sport to
- 3 satisfy the physical education requirement twice per school
- 4 year, the utilization of which must be during the
- 5 <u>interscholastic sport's season.</u>
- 6 (c) As used in this section, the following words and phrases
- 7 shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection unless
- 8 <u>the context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 9 "Interscholastic sport" shall mean athletic contests or
- 10 competitions conducted between or among schools.
- 11 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
