AN ACT

1 Making appropriations to the Hahnemann University, Philadelphia.

2 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

3 hereby enacts as follows:

4 SECTION 1. (A) THE SUM OF \$2,514,000 IS HEREBY APPROPRIATED <—
5 TO THE HAHNEMANN UNIVERSITY, PHILADELPHIA, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR
6 JULY 1, 1992, TO JUNE 30, 1993, FOR INSTRUCTION IN THE DOCTOR OF
7 MEDICINE PROGRAM.

8 (B) THE SUM OF \$459,000 IS HEREBY APPROPRIATED TO THE
9 HAHNEMANN UNIVERSITY, PHILADELPHIA, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JULY 1,
10 1992, TO JUNE 30, 1993, FOR THE GENERAL MAINTENANCE OF THE
11 HAHNEMANN UNIVERSITY, INCLUDING THE ALLIED HEALTH, PROFESSIONS
12 AND GRADUATE SCHOOL OF THE HAHNEMANN UNIVERSITY, AND STUDENT
13 AID.

14 (C) THE SUM OF \$145,000 IS HEREBY APPROPRIATED TO THE
15 HAHNEMANN UNIVERSITY, PHILADELPHIA, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JULY 1,
16 1992, TO JUNE 30, 1993, FOR MINORITY EDUCATIONAL AND RECRUITMENT

1 PROGRAMS.

2 Section ~~1~~ 2. (a) The sum of ~~\$5,028,000~~ \$3,671,000 is hereby <—
3 appropriated to the Hahnemann University, Philadelphia, for the
4 fiscal year July 1, 1993, to June 30, 1994, for instruction in
5 the Doctor of Medicine program.

6 (b) The sum of ~~\$918,000~~ \$689,000 is hereby appropriated to <—
7 the Hahnemann University, Philadelphia, for the fiscal year July
8 1, 1993, to June 30, 1994, for the general maintenance of the
9 Hahnemann University, including the Allied Health, Professions
10 and Graduate School of the Hahnemann University, and student
11 aid.

12 (c) The sum of ~~\$290,000~~ \$217,000 is hereby appropriated to <—
13 the Hahnemann University, Philadelphia, for the fiscal year July
14 1, 1993, to June 30, 1994, for minority educational and
15 recruitment programs.

16 Section ~~2~~ 3. Payments to the Hahnemann University on account <—
17 of the appropriations provided in ~~section 1 shall be made~~ <—
18 ~~quarterly by the Secretary of Education on the basis of costs~~
19 ~~during the fiscal year.~~ <—

20 (1) SECTION 1 SHALL BE MADE IN A LUMP SUM BY THE
21 SECRETARY OF EDUCATION.

22 (2) SECTION 2 SHALL BE MADE QUARTERLY BY THE SECRETARY
23 OF EDUCATION ON THE BASIS OF COSTS DURING THE FISCAL YEAR.

24 Section ~~3~~ 4. The Hahnemann University shall provide full, <—
25 complete and accurate information as may be required by the
26 Department of Education or the majority chairman or the minority
27 chairman of the Appropriations Committee of the Senate or the
28 majority chairman or the minority chairman of the Appropriations
29 Committee of the House of Representatives.

30 Section ~~4~~ 5. The Hahnemann University shall report its <—

1 revenues and expenditures and present its financial statements
2 in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles and
3 procedures for educational institutions as set forth in the
4 "Higher Education Finance Manual (1975)" and the "Commonwealth
5 of Pennsylvania Budget Instructions for the State System of
6 Higher Education, State-Related Universities and Non-State-
7 Related Colleges and Universities."

8 ~~Section 5. This act shall take effect July 1, 1993, or~~ <—
9 ~~immediately, whichever is later.~~

10 SECTION 6. THE HAHNEMANN UNIVERSITY OF PENNSYLVANIA SHALL <—
11 REPORT ON FORMS PROVIDED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO BOTH
12 THE MAJORITY AND MINORITY CHAIRS OF THE SENATE AND HOUSE
13 APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEES BY SEPTEMBER 30, 1994, ON HOW STATE-
14 APPROPRIATED FUNDS WERE EXPENDED FOR FISCAL YEAR 1993-1994 TO
15 REDUCE THE COSTS TO PENNSYLVANIA-RESIDENT STUDENTS OR TO PROVIDE
16 SERVICES TO PENNSYLVANIA RESIDENTS.

17 SECTION 7. THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT AS FOLLOWS:

18 (1) SECTIONS 1 AND 3 OF THIS ACT AND THIS SECTION SHALL
19 TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

20 (2) THE REMAINDER OF THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT JULY 1,
21 1993, OR IMMEDIATELY, WHICHEVER IS LATER.
