AN ACT

Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, repealing FURTHER 3 PROVIDING FOR Access to Justice Act expiration provision. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 4 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 4907 of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania 6 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: +§ 4907. Expiration of chapter. This chapter shall expire in [five] TEN years. HAT LEAST ONE 10 YEAR PRIOR TO THE EXPIRATION OF THIS CHAPTER THE LEGISLATIVE 11 BUDGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEE SHALL CONDUCT AND SUBMIT TO THE 12 GENERAL ASSEMBLY A PERFORMANCE AUDIT FOR THE PURPOSE OF 13 DETERMINING WHETHER THERE IS A CONTINUING JUSTIFICATION FOR THE 14 ACTIVITIES AND LEVEL OF FINANCIAL SUPPORT PROVIDED FOR UNDER 15 THIS CHAPTER. Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately. 16
