- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, further providing for special speed limitations.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Section 3365(b) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 6 Consolidated Statutes is amended and the section is amended by
- 7 adding a subsection to read:
- 8 § 3365. Special speed limitations.
- 9 * * *
- 10 (b) School zones.--When passing a school zone as defined
- 11 [and established] under regulations of the department, no person
- 12 shall drive a vehicle at a speed greater than 15 miles per hour.
- 13 An official traffic-control device shall indicate the beginning
- 14 and end of each school zone to traffic approaching in each
- 15 direction. Establishment of a school zone, including its
- 16 location and hours of operation, shall be approved by [the
- 17 department.] local authorities. Local authorities shall also

- 1 have the power to designate a school crossing as a school zone.

- (e) Definition. -- As used in this section, the term "school 3
- 4 <u>crossing" means a portion of a roadway at an intersection or</u>
- 5 <u>elsewhere distinctly indicated for school children crossing by</u>
- 6 <u>lines or other markings</u>.
- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 7
