AN ACT

1 Amending the act of August 21, 1953 (P.L.1323, No.373), entitled  
2 "An act concerning notaries public; and amending, revising,  
3 consolidating and changing the law relating thereto," further  
4 providing for application to become notary public.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Section 5(a) of the act of August 21, 1953  
8 (P.L.1323, No.373), known as The Notary Public Law, amended  
9 December 9, 2002 (P.L.1269, No.151), is amended to read:

10 Section 5. Application to Become a Notary Public.--(a)  
11 Applications for appointment to the office of notary public  
12 shall be made to the Secretary of the Commonwealth, on forms  
13 prescribed and furnished by the secretary, and shall be  
14 accompanied by a non-refundable filing fee as set forth in  
15 section 618-A of the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175),  
16 known as "The Administrative Code of 1929," payable to the order  
17 of the "Commonwealth of Pennsylvania." [Each application shall  
18 bear the endorsement of the Senator of the district in which the  
19 applicant resides or, if the applicant does not reside in this

1 Commonwealth, the endorsement of the Senator of the district in  
2 which the applicant is employed. In the case of a vacancy in  
3 that senatorial district, the application shall be endorsed by  
4 the Senator of an adjacent district.]

6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
