1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9	Amending the act of December 19, 1988 (P.L.1262, No.156), entitled "An act providing for the licensing of clubs to conduct games of chance, for the licensing of persons to distribute games of chance, for the registration of manufacturers of games of chance, and for suspensions and revocations of licenses and permits; requiring records; providing for local referendum by electorate; and prescribing penalties," providing for annual raffles by amateur athletic organizations and amateur sports booster clubs.

11	hereby enacts as follows:
12	Section 1. The act of December 19, 1988 (P.L.1262, No.156),
13	known as the Local Option Small Games of Chance Act, is amended
14	by adding a section to read:
15	Section 4.1. Annual raffle by amateur athletic organizations
16	and sports booster clubs.
17	(a) Raffle authorizedNotwithstanding any other provision
18	of this act, an amateur athletic organization or amateur sports
19	booster club may conduct one raffle each calendar year. The
20	amateur athletic organization or amateur sports booster
21	<u>organization shall not be required to obtain a license or</u>

special permit, but shall be required to give the department 1 notice of its intention to conduct a raffle in accordance with 2 3 department rules and regulations. (b) Prize and ticket limits. -- The maximum cash value which 4 5 may be awarded for any single chance shall not exceed \$500 and the cost of a ticket shall not exceed \$1. 6 7 (c) Use of funds.--All proceeds from an annual raffle 8 conducted under this section shall be used exclusively for 9 legitimate amateur athletic purposes. (d) Local option inapplicable. -- An amateur athletic 10 11 organization or sports booster club may conduct an annual raffle 12 regardless of the results of an election conducted under section 13 14. (e) Rules and regulations.--The department shall promulgate 14 15 rules and regulations to administer and enforce the provisions of thi<u>s section.</u> 16 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 17
