AS AMENDED ON SECOND CONSIDERATION, JUNE 3, 1986

AN ACT

1 Making an appropriation from the Workmen's Compensation
2 Administration Fund to the Department of Labor and Industry
3 to provide for the expenses of administering The Pennsylvania
4 Workmen's Compensation Act and The Pennsylvania Occupational
5 Disease Act for the fiscal year July 1, 1986, to June 30,
6 1987, and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining
7 unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 1986.

8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
9 hereby enacts as follows:

10 Section 1. The sum of ~~\$11,755,000~~ \$11,281,000, or as much <—
11 thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the
12 Workmen's Compensation Administration Fund to the Department of
13 Labor and Industry for the payment of all salaries, wages and
14 other compensation and travel expenses, for contractual services
15 and other expenses necessary for the administration of the act
16 of June 2, 1915 (P.L.736, No.338), known as The Pennsylvania
17 Workmen's Compensation Act, and the act of June 21, 1939
18 (P.L.566, No.284), known as The Pennsylvania Occupational
19 Disease Act, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1986, and for
20 the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close

1 of the fiscal year ending June 30, 1986.

2 SECTION 2. THE SUM OF \$474,000, OR AS MUCH THEREOF AS MAY BE <—
3 NECESSARY, IS HEREBY APPROPRIATED FROM THE WORKMEN'S
4 COMPENSATION ADMINISTRATION FUND TO THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND
5 INDUSTRY FOR THE PAYMENT OF SALARIES, WAGES AND OTHER
6 COMPENSATION NECESSARY FOR INCREASING THE FILLED COMPLEMENT
7 LEVEL OF WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION REFEREES TO 49 AND FOR THE
8 PAYMENT OF SALARIES, WAGES AND OTHER COMPENSATION NECESSARY TO
9 PROVIDE TWO CLERICAL SUPPORT PERSONNEL FOR EACH REFEREE IN
10 WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION FIELD OFFICES.

11 Section ~~2~~ 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 1986, or <—
12 immediately, whichever is later.
