- 2 SECTION 2. THE SUM OF \$474,000, OR AS MUCH THEREOF AS MAY BE <-
- 3 NECESSARY, IS HEREBY APPROPRIATED FROM THE WORKMEN'S
- 4 COMPENSATION ADMINISTRATION FUND TO THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND
- 5 INDUSTRY FOR THE PAYMENT OF SALARIES, WAGES AND OTHER
- 6 COMPENSATION NECESSARY FOR INCREASING THE FILLED COMPLEMENT
- 7 LEVEL OF WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION REFEREES TO 49 AND FOR THE
- 8 PAYMENT OF SALARIES, WAGES AND OTHER COMPENSATION NECESSARY TO
- 9 PROVIDE TWO CLERICAL SUPPORT PERSONNEL FOR EACH REFEREE IN
- 10 WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION FIELD OFFICES.
