AN ACT

- Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the 3 executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the Executive Department thereof and the administrative 4 5 departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, 6 including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or 7 8 authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative 9 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative 10 officers, and of the several administrative departments, 11 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the 12 13 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive 14 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and 15 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, 16 17 and commissions; and prescribing the manner in which the number and compensation of the deputies and all other assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and 18 19 commissions shall be determined, " providing for reciprocity 20 21 in teacher certification; and making an editorial change.

- 23 hereby enacts as follows:
- 24 Section 1. The introductory paragraph of section 1304 of the
- 25 act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known as The
- 26 Administrative Code of 1929, is amended and the section is
- 27 amended by adding a subsection to read:

- Section 1304. Professional Education and Licensure. -- The 1
- 2 Department of [Public Instruction] Education shall have the
- 3 power, and its duty shall be:

- 5 (e.1) To establish reciprocity with other states regarding
- 6 teacher certification, provided that the certification
- 7 requirements of this Commonwealth are met.

- 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
