AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
2 Statutes, providing for a special preserve our heritage  
3 registration plate.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

8 § 1353. Preserve our heritage registration plate.

9 The department, in consultation with the Pennsylvania  
10 Historical and Museum Commission, shall design a special  
11 preserve our heritage registration plate. Upon receipt of an  
12 application, accompanied by a fee of \$35 which shall be in  
13 addition to the annual registration fee, the department shall  
14 issue the plate for a passenger car, motor home, trailer or  
15 truck with a gross vehicle weight rating of not more than 9,000  
16 pounds. The Historical Preservation Fund shall receive \$15 of  
17 each additional fee for this plate.

18 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 120 days.
