AN ACT

Implementing the provisions of Article VII, section 10 of the 1 Constitution of Pennsylvania, by designating the Commonwealth 2 officers who shall be charged with the function of auditing 3 4 the financial transactions after the occurence thereof of the Legislative and Judicial branches of the government of the 5 6 Commonwealth. 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 8 9 Section 1. Audits of Affairs of the General Assembly, Legislative Agencies .-- It shall be the duty of the Legislative 10 Budget and Finance Committee of the General Assembly of this 11 Commonwealth to make all audits of transactions after their 12 13 occurrence which may be necessary in connection with the administration of the financial affairs of the General Assembly, 14 or its legislative service agencies, with the exception of the 15 affairs of the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee. Such 16 17 audits of the affairs of the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee shall be made by an independent auditing committee 18 consisting of three qualified persons who shall be appointed by 19 the Majority Leader of the Senate, the Minority Leader of the 20

- 1 Senate, the Majority Leader of the House of Representatives and
- 2 the Minority Leader of the House of Representatives.
- 3 At least one such audit shall be made each year; however,
- 4 special audits may be made when they appear necessary in the
- 5 judgment of the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee.
- 6 Section 2. Audits of Affairs of the Several Courts of the
- 7 Commonwealth. -- It shall be the duty of the chief-administrative

- 8 officer-of-the-Supreme-Court-of-Pennsylvania STATE COURT
- 9 ADMINISTRATOR to make all audits of transactions after their
- 10 occurrence which may be necessary in connection with the
- 11 administration of the several courts under the unified judical
- 12 system of this Commonwealth, with the exception of the affairs
- 13 of the Supreme Court. Such audits of the affairs of the Supreme
- 14 Court AND OF THE STATE COURT ADMINISTRATOR shall be made by an
- 15 independent auditing committee consisting of three qualified
- 16 persons who shall be appointed by the Chief-Justice-of-the
- 17 Supreme-Court- PRESIDENT JUDGE OF THE SUPERIOR COURT.
- 18 Section 3. Effective Date. -- This act shall take effect July
- 19 17-1969 IMMEDIATELY.
