AN ACT

1 Making an appropriation for allocation to the Office of the
2 Governor, the State Treasurer, and to Motor License Fund
3 administrative departments, boards and commissions and other
4 agencies under the jurisdiction of the Governor and imposing
5 duties on the Governor with respect to making allocations
6 thereof to provide for special salary or wage increases for
7 State employees.

8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
9 hereby enacts as follows:

10 Section 1. The sum of eight million one hundred thousand
11 dollars (\$8,100,000), or as much thereof as may be necessary, is
12 hereby appropriated and allocated to the Office of the Governor,
13 the State Treasurer and to Motor License Fund administrative
14 departments, boards and commissions and other agencies which are
15 part of the executive branch of the State Government for the
16 purpose of providing funds for a cost-of-living salary or wage
17 increase for the fiscal year 1971-1972 for State employees in
18 such offices, departments, boards, commissions and other
19 agencies.

20 Section 2. The Governor shall provide a plan and make
21 allocations from this appropriation to the various offices,

1 departments or agencies for the 1971-1972 fiscal year in such
2 amounts as may be necessary to provide funds for a cost-of-
3 living salary or wage increase for State employes in such
4 offices, departments or agencies.

5 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
