AN ACT

Amending the act of July 7, 1972 (No.17-A), entitled "An act to provide for the expenses of the Executive, Legislative and 3 Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth, the public debt and for the public schools for the fiscal year July 1, 1972 to 4 June 30, 1973, and for the payment of bills incurred and 5 6 remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal period ending June 30, 1972, changing, adding and deleting certain 7 8 appropriations to the Executive and Legislative Departments. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 10 hereby enacts as follows: 11 Section 1. As much as relates to certain appropriations to 12 the Departments of Community Affairs, Education, Health, 13 Property and Supplies, Public Welfare and State and to the 14 Senate, House of Representatives and the Legislative Reference 15 Bureau in section 2, act of July 7, 1972 (No.17-A), known as "The General Appropriation Act of 1972," is amended AND AN 16 17 APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION IS ADDED AFTER THE 18 APPROPRIATION TO PUBLIC LIBRARIES to read: 19 The following sums, or as much thereof as may be Section 2. 20 necessary, are hereby specifically appropriated from the General 21 Fund to the several hereinafter named agencies of the Executive,
