INTRODUCED BY SELTZER, MAY 29, 1973

REFERRED TO COMMITTEE ON APPROPRIATIONS, MAY 29, 1973

A SUPPLEMENT

1 To the act of November 30, 1965 (P.L.843, No.355), entitled "An  
2 act providing for the establishment and operation of Temple  
3 University as an instrumentality of the Commonwealth to serve  
4 as a State-related university in the higher education system  
5 of the Commonwealth; providing for change of name; providing  
6 for the composition of the board of trustees; terms of  
7 trustees, and the power and duties of such trustees;  
8 providing for preference to Pennsylvania residents in  
9 tuition; providing for public support and capital  
10 improvements; authorizing appropriations in amounts to be  
11 fixed annually by the General Assembly; providing for the  
12 auditing of accounts of expenditures from said  
13 appropriations; authorizing the issuance of bonds exempt from  
14 taxation within the Commonwealth; requiring the President to  
15 make an annual report of the operations of Temple  
16 University," making appropriations for carrying the same into  
17 effect, providing for a basis for payments of such  
18 appropriation and providing a method of accounting for the  
19 funds appropriated.

20 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
21 hereby enacts as follows:

22 Section 1. The following sums, or as much thereof as may be  
23 necessary, are hereby specifically appropriated to the Trustees  
24 of Temple University at Philadelphia for the fiscal year July 1,  
25 1973 to June 30, 1974, for the purposes and in the amounts as  
26 shown:

27 (1) For net cost of instruction excluding

1	Doctor of Medicine.....	\$45,280,000
2	(2) For net cost of student aid.....	1,785,000
3	(3) For net cost of extension and	
4	public services.....	52,000
5	(4) For instruction - Doctor of Medicine	
6	only.....	5,345,000

7 Section 2. Payments to Temple University on account of the  
8 appropriations for all items, as provided in section 1 of this  
9 act, except for instruction Doctor of Medicine, shall be made on  
10 the basis of net costs during the fiscal year.

11 Payments for instruction - Doctor of Medicine only shall be  
12 made on the basis of full-time equivalent students enrolled at  
13 the rate of seven thousand four hundred sixty-five dollars  
14 (\$7,465) per student.

15 Section 3. If necessary, Temple University may transfer  
16 funds among the appropriations listed in section 1, clause (1),  
17 (2) and (3): Provided, That the aggregate amount transferred  
18 into or out of each appropriation during the fiscal year shall  
19 not exceed ten per cent of the amount specifically appropriated  
20 for that purpose.

21 Section 4. Payment to Temple University of the  
22 appropriations herein provided shall be made quarterly during  
23 the fiscal year as follows:

- 24 (1) First payment on September 30, 1973.
- 25 (2) Second payment on December 31, 1973.
- 26 (3) Third payment on March 31, 1974.
- 27 (4) Fourth payment on June 30, 1974.

28 Such quarterly payments shall be made in accordance with the  
29 provisions of sections 2 and 3 of this act, on the basis of  
30 estimated net costs and full-time equivalent students enrolled

1 in the Doctor of Medicine program. The estimate of net costs  
2 shall be submitted by Temple University to the Secretary of  
3 Education, the General Assembly and to the State Treasurer not  
4 later than thirty days prior to the date on which such payment  
5 is to be made.

6 Section 5. Temple University shall apply the moneys  
7 appropriated by this act only for such purposes as are permitted  
8 in this act and shall at all times maintain proper records  
9 showing the application of such moneys. Not later than one  
10 hundred twenty days after the close of the fiscal year to which  
11 this act relates, Temple University shall file with the  
12 Secretary of Education, the General Assembly and with the  
13 Auditor General of the Commonwealth a statement setting forth  
14 the amounts and purposes of all expenditures made from moneys  
15 appropriated by this act and other university accounts during  
16 said fiscal year the number of full-time equivalent students  
17 enrolled in the Doctor of Medicine program and net costs, as  
18 provided in section 2 of this act, used as a basis for receipt  
19 of any appropriation during said fiscal year. Such statement of  
20 expenditures, and number of full-time equivalent students  
21 enrolled in the Doctor of Medicine program and net costs shall  
22 be reviewed by the Auditor General of the Commonwealth, and he  
23 shall have the right, in respect to the moneys appropriated by  
24 this act, to audit and disallow expenditures made for purposes  
25 not permitted by this act and to cause such sums to be recovered  
26 and paid by Temple University to the Treasurer of the  
27 Commonwealth. The Auditor General shall also make a  
28 determination of full-time equivalent students enrolled in the  
29 Doctor of Medicine program and net costs and make certification  
30 as to their correctness. In respect to expenditures made by the

1 university from moneys other than those appropriated by this  
2 act, the Auditor General shall have the right to review only and  
3 he shall file annually with the General Assembly such  
4 information concerning said expenditures as the General Assembly  
5 or any of its committees may require.

6       Section 6. The university shall report its revenues and  
7 expenditures and present its financial statements required under  
8 the provisions of this act in accordance with generally accepted  
9 accounting principles and procedures for educational  
10 institutions as set forth in "College and University Business  
11 Administration" of the American Council on Education, Revised  
12 Edition, 1968, without exception.

13       Section 7. This act shall take effect July 1, 1973.
