# HOUSE BILL No. 1001 Session of 1973

### INTRODUCED BY MR. SELTZER, MAY 29, 1973

AS AMENDED ON SECOND CONSIDERATION, IN SENATE, OCTOBER 1, 1973

#### A SUPPLEMENT

1 To the act of November 30, 1965 (P.L.843, No.355), entitled "An 2 act providing for the establishment and operation of Temple University as an instrumentality of the Commonwealth to serve 3 as a State-related university in the higher education system 4 5 of the Commonwealth; providing for change of name; providing 6 for the composition of the board of trustees; terms of 7 trustees, and the power and duties of such trustees; providing for preference to Pennsylvania residents in 8 9 tuition; providing for public support and capital improvements; authorizing appropriations in amounts to be 10 fixed annually by the General Assembly; providing for the 11 auditing of accounts of expenditures from said 12 13 appropriations; authorizing the issuance of bonds exempt from 14 taxation within the Commonwealth; requiring the President to make an annual report of the operations of Temple 15 University," making appropriations for carrying the same into 16 17 effect, providing for a basis for payments of such 18 appropriation and providing a method of accounting for the 19 funds appropriated.

20 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

21 hereby enacts as follows:

22 Section 1. The following sums, or as much thereof as may be 23 necessary, are hereby specifically appropriated to the Trustees 24 of Temple University at Philadelphia for the fiscal year July 1, 25 1973 to June 30, 1974, for the purposes and in the amounts as 26 shown:

11	Section 2. Payments to Temple University on account of the	
12	appropriations for all items, as provided in section 1 of this	
13	act, except for instruction Doctor of Medicine, shall be made on	
14	the basis of net costs during the fiscal year.	
15	Payments for instruction - Doctor of Medicine only shall be	
16	made on the basis of full-time equivalent students enrolled at	
17	the rate of seven thousand four hundred sixty-five dollars	
18	(\$7,465) per student.	
19	Section 3. If necessary, Temple University may transfer	
20	funds among the appropriations listed in section 1, <del>clause (1),</del>	<
21	CLAUSES (1) AND (2) and $(3)$ : Provided, That the aggregate amount	<
22	transferred into or out of each appropriation during the fiscal	
23	year shall not exceed ten per cent of the amount specifically	
24	appropriated for that purpose.	
25	Section 4. Payment to Temple University of the	
26	appropriations herein provided shall be made <del>quarterly</del> MONTHLY	<
27	during the fiscal year. <del>as follows:</del>	<—
28	(1) First payment on September 30, 1973.	
29	(2) Second payment on December 31, 1973.	
30	(3) Third payment on March 31, 1974.	
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#### (4) Fourth payment on June 30, 1974.

Such quarterly MONTHLY payments shall be made in accordance 2 3 with the provisions of sections 2 and 3 of this act, on the 4 basis of estimated net costs and full-time equivalent students 5 enrolled in the Doctor of Medicine program. The estimate of net costs shall be submitted by Temple University to the Secretary 6 7 of Education, the General Assembly and to the State Treasurer 8 not later than thirty days prior to the date on which such 9 payment is to be made.

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10 Section 5. Temple University shall apply the moneys 11 appropriated by this act only for such purposes as are permitted in this act and shall at all times maintain proper records 12 showing the application of such moneys. Not later than one 13 14 hundred twenty days after the close of the fiscal year to which 15 this act relates, Temple University shall file with the 16 Secretary of Education, the General Assembly and with the 17 Auditor General of the Commonwealth a statement setting forth 18 the amounts and purposes of all expenditures made from moneys 19 appropriated by this act and other university accounts during 20 said fiscal year the number of full-time equivalent students 21 enrolled in the Doctor of Medicine program and net costs, as 22 provided in section 2 of this act, used as a basis for receipt 23 of any appropriation during said fiscal year. Such statement of 24 expenditures, and number of full-time equivalent students 25 enrolled in the Doctor of Medicine program and net costs shall 26 be reviewed by the Auditor General of the Commonwealth, and he 27 shall have the right, in respect to the moneys appropriated by 28 this act, to audit and disallow expenditures made for purposes 29 not permitted by this act and to cause such sums to be recovered and paid by Temple University to the Treasurer of the 30 19730H1001B1756 - 3 -

Commonwealth. The Auditor General shall also make a 1 2 determination of full-time equivalent students enrolled in the Doctor of Medicine program and net costs and make certification 3 4 as to their correctness. In respect to expenditures made by the 5 university from moneys other than those appropriated by this act, the Auditor General shall have the right to review only and 6 he shall file annually with the General Assembly such 7 8 information concerning said expenditures as the General Assembly 9 or any of its committees may require.

19 REPORT, TO BE SUBMITTED PRIOR TO NOVEMBER 1, 1974, SHALL COVER
20 THE TWELVE-MONTH PERIOD BEGINNING SEPTEMBER 1, 1973. EACH REPORT

TO ALL <----17 FACULTY MEMBERS IN EACH CLASSIFICATION. 18 (3) FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1973 1974 IDENTIFY BY SCHOOL, 19 DEPARTMENT, AND TITLE EACH FULL TIME FACULTY MEMBER AND PROVIDE 20 THE NUMBER OF CONTACT HOURS ASSIGNED TO HIM PER WEEK DURING EACH 21 TERM, THE AVERAGE NUMBER OF HOURS PER WEEK SPENT BY HIM ON 22 ACADEMIC PREPARATION, AND THE TOTAL AVERAGE NUMBER OF HOURS PER 23 WEEK SPENT BY HIM ON UNIVERSITY RELATED WORK. 24 (3) For each term of the period covered an analysis of the <-----25 average hours per week spent in university-related activities 26 for each full-time faculty member identified by school, 27 department and title. 28 Section 7. In addition to the requirements of section 6, the report covering the twelve-month period beginning September 1, 29

30 1973 shall include for all programs of the university except the

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1 Doctor of Medicine program:

2 (1) Minimum number of credits required for a baccalaureate3 degree, and for a master's degree.

4 (2) Number of bachelor's degrees, master's degrees, first
5 professional degrees, and doctoral degrees awarded in 1971,
6 1972, 1973, and estimated 1974.

7 Section 6. 7. 8. The university shall report its revenues 8 and expenditures and present its financial statements required 9 under the provisions of this act in accordance with generally 10 accepted accounting principles and procedures for educational 11 institutions as set forth in "College and University Business 12 Administration" of the American Council on Education, Revised 13 Edition, 1968, without exception. <-----

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Section 7. 8. 9. This act shall take effect July 1, 1973
