## AN ACT

- 1 Authorizing the Department of Property and Supplies, with the
- 2 approval of the Governor and the Secretary of Transportation,
- 3 to sell and convey certain lots or tracts of ground with
- 4 improvements thereon situate in Lower Allen Township,
- 5 Cumberland County.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. The Department of Property and Supplies, with the
- 9 approval of the Governor and the Secretary of Transportation, is
- 10 hereby authorized on behalf of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 11 to sell, at public sale, to the highest bidder and convey all
- 12 or/and any of the following described tracts of land with any
- 13 improvements thereon situate in Lower Allen Township, County of
- 14 Cumberland, in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania:
- 15 Tract No. 1. All that certain tract or parcel of land with
- 16 the buildings and improvements thereon erected, situate in Lower
- 17 Allen Township, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania more
- 18 particularly bounded and described as follows, to wit:
- 19 Beginning at a point on the Northerly line of Kensington
- 20 Drive, which point is 240.20 feet West of the Northwesterly

- 1 corner of Kensington Drive and Scarsdale Drive (both extended)
- 2 and at the dividing line between Lots Nos. 4 and 5, Block "A" on
- 3 the hereinafter mentioned Plan of Lots; thence along the
- 4 Northerly line of Kensington Drive in an arc curving to the left
- 5 having a radius of 160 feet in a Westerly direction 36.22 feet
- 6 to a point; thence further along the Northerly line of
- 7 Kensington Drive South 55 degrees 20 minutes West 38.78 feet to
- 8 a point at the dividing line between Lots Nos. 5 and 6, Block
- 9 "A" on said Plan; thence along said dividing line North 34
- 10 degrees 40 minutes West 140 feet to a point; thence North 55
- 11 degrees 20 minutes East 107.88 feet to a point, at dividing line
- 12 between Lots Nos. 4 and 5, Block "A" aforesaid; thence along
- 13 same South 21 degrees 42 minutes East 147.85 feet to a point,
- 14 the place of Beginning.
- Being Lot No. 5, Block "A", in Plan of Lots for Country and
- 16 Town Homes, Inc., prepared by D. P. Raffensperger, Registered
- 17 Surveyor, in Lemoyne, Pa., dated October 25, 1955, which Plan
- 18 was recorded in the Cumberland County Recorder's Office on May
- 19 14, 1956, in Plan Book 7, Page 41.
- 20 Having thereon erected a one story brick dwelling known as
- 21 No. 7 Kensington Drive.
- 22 Being the same Premises conveyed to the Commonwealth of
- 23 Pennsylvania by deed of Rodney A. Felix and Velma R. Felix, his
- 24 wife, dated August 5, 1968, and recorded September 20, 1968, in
- 25 the Recorder of Deeds Office of Cumberland County in Deed Book
- 26 Y-22, Page 255.
- 27 Tract No. 2. All that certain lot or piece of ground with
- 28 the buildings and improvements thereon erected, situate in the
- 29 Township of Lower Allen, County of Cumberland and State of
- 30 Pennsylvania, more particularly bounded and described by a

- 1 Survey of D. P. Raffensperger, Registered Surveyor, made May 7,
- 2 1959.
- 3 Beginning at a point on the Northerly line of Kensington
- 4 Drive (50 feet wide) which point is 170.20 feet measured
- 5 Westwardly from the intersection of the said Kensington Drive
- 6 with Scarsdale Drive, and which point is on the line dividing
- 7 Lots Nos. 2 and 4, Block "A", on the hereinafter mentioned Plan
- 8 of Lots thence along Kensington Drive aforesaid in an arc having
- 9 a radius of 160 feet in a Westerly direction, an arc distance of
- 10 70 feet to a point in the line dividing Lots Nos. 4 and 5, Block
- 11 "A", on the aforesaid plan; thence North 21 degrees, 42 minutes
- 12 West along said dividing line 147.85 feet to a stake in the
- 13 Southerly right of way line of new Route 15; thence North 55
- 14 degrees 20 minutes East along said line 75.69 feet to a stake in
- 15 the line dividing Lots Nos. 3 and 4, Block "A", on the said
- 16 plan; thence South 34 degrees 40 minutes East along said
- 17 dividing line 109.99 feet to a stake; thence South 1 degree 11
- 18 minutes West along the line dividing Lots 2 and 4, Block "A" on
- 19 said plan, 78.91 feet to a point in the Northerly line of
- 20 Kensington Drive, being the place of Beginning.
- 21 Being Lot No. 4, Block "A" on Plan of Lots known as Country
- 22 and Town Homes, Inc. which plan is recorded in the Office for
- 23 the Recording of Deeds in and for Cumberland County,
- 24 Pennsylvania in Plan Book 7, Page 41. House No. 5 Kensington
- 25 Drive.
- 26 Being the same premises conveyed to the Commonwealth of
- 27 Pennsylvania by deed of Charles J. Boova and Naomi M. Boova, his
- 28 wife, dated August 16, 1968, and recorded September 16, 1968, in
- 29 the Recorder of Deeds Office of Cumberland County in Deed Book
- 30 X-22, Page 969.

- 1 These conveyances shall be made under and subject,
- 2 nevertheless, to all easements, servitudes and rights of others,
- 3 including, but not confined to streets, roadways, and rights of
- 4 any telephone, telegraph, water, electric, gas or pipeline
- 5 companies, as well as under and subject, nevertheless, to any
- 6 estate or tenancies vested in third persons, whether or not
- 7 appearing of record, for any portion of the said land or
- 8 improvements erected thereon.
- 9 Section 2. The deed of conveyance shall be approved by the
- 10 Department of Justice and shall be executed by the Secretary of
- 11 Property and Supplies in the name of the Commonwealth of
- 12 Pennsylvania.
- 13 Section 3. All moneys received from the sale of the lands
- 14 herein authorized to be conveyed shall be deposited in the Motor
- 15 License Fund.
- 16 Section 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
