AN ACT

- 1 Designating a certain bridge crossing the Susquehanna River as 2 the John Harris Memorial Bridge.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. The bridge carrying Interstate Route 83 over the
- 6 Susquehanna River between Harrisburg in Dauphin County and
- 7 Lemoyne in Cumberland County is hereby officially designated and
- 8 shall be known as the "John Harris Memorial Bridge."
- 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
