AN ACT

1 Repealing the act of August 11, 1941 (P.L.900, No.344), entitled
2 "An act defining and prohibiting unfair sales, providing
3 remedies for violations thereof, and establishing penalties
4 therefor."

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. The act of August 11, 1941 (P.L.900, No.344)
8 known as the "Unfair Sales Act," is repealed.

9 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
