AN ACT

1 Repealing the act of June 5, 1935 (P.L.266, No.115), entitled  
2 "An act to protect trade-mark owners, distributors, and the  
3 public against injuries and uneconomic practices in the  
4 distribution of articles of standard quality under a  
5 distinguished trade-mark, brand or name."

6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
7 hereby enacts as follows:

8 Section 1. The act of June 5, 1935 (P.L.266, No.115),  
9 entitled "An act to protect trade-mark owners, distributors, and  
10 the public against injuries and uneconomic practices in the  
11 distribution of articles of standard quality under a  
12 distinguished trade-mark, brand or name," is repealed.

13 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
