AN ACT

- Amending the act of June 26, 1974 (No.21-A), entitled "An act to provide for the expenses of the Executive, Legislative and Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth, the public debt and 3 for the public schools for the fiscal year July 1, 1974 to June 30, 1975, and for the payment of bills incurred and 6 remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal period ending 7 June 30, 1974; and providing for subpoena powers for legislative appropriation committees," providing for a 9 deficiency in the appropriation to the Department of Justice AND IN THE APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WELFARE. 10 11 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 12 hereby enacts as follows: 13 Section 1. - 19 Section 2. The following sums, or as much thereof as may be

4	payment of the salaries, wages or other compensation and travel			
5	expense of the duly elected or appointed officers and employees			
6	of the Commonwealth, for payment of fees of contractual services			
7	rendered, for the purchase or rental of goods, services,			
8	printing, equipment, land and buildings and for payment of any			
9	other expenses, as provided by law or by this act, necessary for			
10	the proper conduct of the duties, functions and activities and			
11	for the purposes hereinafter set forth for the fiscal year			
12	beginning July 1, 1974 and for the payment of bills incurred and			
13	remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal period ending June
