7	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania	
8	hereby enacts as follows:	
9	Section 1. The Department of Property and Supplies, with the	
10	approval of the Department of Public Welfare and the Governor,	
11	is hereby authorized and directed on behalf of the Commonwealth	
12	of Pennsylvania, to grant and convey to the Township of Upper	
13	St. Clair the following tract of land situate in the Township of	
14	Upper St. Clair, County of Allegheny, and Commonwealth of	
15	Pennsylvania, bounded and described as follows:	
16	Beginning at a point in the center of Morton Road (L.R.	<
17	02054), said point being south 01 degrees 07 minutes 00 second	
18	east a distance of 1193.83 feet from the centerline intersection	
19	of Morrow Road (also L.R. 02054) and said Morton Road; thence	
20	from said point of beginning through lands of the grantor herein

- 2 feet to a point, said described line being 50 feet from, and
- 3 parallel to, the southerly side of lands now or late of the
- 4 school district of Upper St. Clair Township; thence continuing
- 5 through lands of the grantor herein south 01 degrees 07 minutes
- 6 00 seconds east a distance of 1003.79 feet to a point; thence
- 7 continuing by same north 72 degrees 02 minutes 30 seconds east a
- 8 distance of 625.71 feet to a point in the centerline of Morton
- 9 Road (L.R. 02054); thence along the centerline of said Morton
- 10 Road north 17 degrees 57 minutes 30 seconds west a distance of
- 11 571.24 feet to a point; thence continuing by same north 02
- 12 degrees 53 minutes 00 seconds west a distance of 271.42 feet to
- 13 a point; thence continuing by same north 01 degrees 07 minutes
- 14 00 seconds west a distance of 4.47 feet to the point of
- 15 beginning. Containing 10.44 acres, more or less, of land, used
- 16 by the Mayview State Hospital.
- BEGINNING AT A POINT IN THE CENTERLINE OF MORTON ROAD (L.R.

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- 18 02054) AT THE INTERSECTION OF HASTINGS MILL ROAD (ALSO L.R.
- 19 02054); THENCE FROM SAID POINT OF BEGINNING, ALONG THE
- 20 CENTERLINE OF MORTON ROAD (TOWNSHIP ROAD) SOUTH 10 DEGREES 04
- 21 MINUTES 30 SECONDS WEST A DISTANCE OF 270.12 FEET TO A POINT;
- 22 THENCE CONTINUING BY SAME, NORTH 86 DEGREES 56 MINUTES 00
- 23 SECONDS WEST A DISTANCE OF 339.58 FEET TO A POINT; THENCE BY A
- 24 LINE THROUGH MORTON ROAD AND LANDS OF COMMONWEALTH OF
- 25 PENNSYLVANIA, NORTH 3 DEGREES 04 SECONDS 00 MINUTES EAST A
- 26 DISTANCE OF 350.00 FEET TO A POINT; THENCE BY A LINE THROUGH
- 27 LANDS OF COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA AND THROUGH MORTON ROAD
- 28 (L.R. 02054) SOUTH 86 DEGREES 56 SECONDS 00 MINUTES EAST A
- 29 DISTANCE OF 345.85 FEET TO A POINT IN THE CENTERLINE OF SAID
- 30 MORTON ROAD (L.R. 02054); THENCE BY THE CENTERLINE OF MORTON

- 1 ROAD (L.R. 02054) SOUTH 14 DEGREES 59 MINUTES 00 SECONDS EAST A
- 2 DISTANCE OF 86.14 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING. CONTAINING
- 3 2.87 ACRES.
- 4 The conveyance shall be made under and subject to all
- 5 easements, servitudes and rights of others, including but not
- 6 confined to streets, roadways, and rights of any telephone,
- 7 telegraph, water, electric, sewer, gas or pipeline companies, as
- 8 well as under and subject to any interest, estates, or tenancies
- 9 vested in third persons, whether or not appearing of record, for
- 10 any portion of the land or improvements erected thereon.
- 11 Section 2. The deed of conveyance shall contain a clause
- 12 that the lands conveyed shall be used for public safety purposes

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- 13 THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SECOND FIRE STATION by the Township of
- 14 Upper St. Clair and if at any time the said Township of Upper
- 15 St. Clair or its successor in function conveys said property or
- 16 authorizes or permits said property to be used for any purpose
- 17 other than public safety purposes OR GENERAL GOVERNMENT
- 18 PURPOSES, the title thereto shall immediately revert to and
- 19 revest in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
- 20 Section 3. The deed of conveyance shall be approved by the
- 21 Department of Justice and shall be executed by the Secretary of
- 22 Property and Supplies in the name of the Commonwealth of
- 23 Pennsylvania.
- 24 Section 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
