## AN ACT

1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10	Amending the act of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323, No.130), entitled "An act relating to counties of the third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth classes; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," providing for an increase to veterans' organizations for observance of Memorial Day and Veterans' Day, providing funds to observe Independence Day, July fourth and changing an appropriation. FURTHER PROVIDING FOR APPROPRIATIONS TO VETERANS' ORGANIZATIONS FOR EXPENSES OF OBSERVING CERTAIN HOLIDAYS.
11	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
12	hereby enacts as follows:
13	Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 1921, act of August 9,
14	1955 (P.L.323, No.130), known as "The County Code," amended June
15	6, 1963 (P.L.90, No.63), is amended to read:
16	Section 1921. Appropriations to Veterans' Organizations for
17	Expenses of Memorial Day; Veterans' Day and Independence Day
18	(a) The board of commissioners may appropriate, annually, to
19	each camp of the United Spanish War Veterans, and to each post
20	of the American Legion, and to each post of the Veterans of
21	Foreign Wars, and to each post of the Veterans of World War I of

the U. S. A., Inc., and to each post of the American War 1 Veterans of World War II (AMVETS), and to each post of the 2 3 Society of the Twenty-eighth Division, AEF, Incorporated, and to 4 each post of the Italian American War Veterans of the United 5 States, Incorporated, and to each detachment of the Marine Corps League, and to each Naval Association, and to each post of the 6 Grand Army of the Republic, and to each post of the Disabled 7 8 American Veterans of the World War, and to each organization of American Gold Star Mothers, and to each organization of ex-9 10 service men incorporated under the act of April twenty-nine, one 11 thousand eight hundred seventy-four (Pamphlet Laws 73), and the supplements thereto, in the county, [a sum not to exceed {three 12 <-----13 hundred dollars (\$300)] <u>five hundred dollars (\$500) for each</u> <-----14 day, ANY SUM BUDGETED to aid in defraying the expenses of <----15 Memorial Day [and Armistice Day], Veterans' Day and Independence 16 Day. July fourth: Provided, That for July 4, 1976 a sum not to <-----17 exceed one thousand dollars (\$1,000) may be appropriated. 18 \* \* \*

19 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
