## AN ACT

Amending the act of April 28, 1937 (P.L.417, No.105), entitled, 2 as amended, "An act relating to milk and the products thereof; creating a Milk Marketing Board; establishing its 3 4 jurisdiction, powers and duties; regulating the production, 5 transportation, manufacturing, processing, storage, distribution, delivery and sale of milk and certain products 7 thereof; providing for the licensing of milk dealers and the payment of fees therefor; requiring milk dealers to file 8 9 bonds to secure payment for milk to producers and certain 10 milk dealers; authorizing the holding of hearings and the issuance of subpoenas by the board; conferring jurisdiction 11 upon courts to punish contempts and to prohibit violations of 12 13 this act and of rules, regulations and orders of the board; 14 authorizing the board to adopt rules, regulations and orders, 15 and to enter into interstate and Federal compacts; requiring 16 persons who weigh, measure, sample or test milk to procure 17 permits or certificates, to take examinations, to pay fees 18 therefor, to furnish certain notices, records and statements, 19 and to use certain methods of weighing, measuring, sampling 20 and testing; authorizing the board to examine the business, 21 papers and premises of milk dealers and producers, requiring 22 the keeping of records and the filing of reports by milk 23 dealers, and permitting, with limitations, the use of 24 information obtained thereby; authorizing the board to fix prices for milk and certain milk products subject to the 25 26 approval of the Governor, and conferring certain powers upon the Governor with respect thereto; providing for appeals to 27 28 the courts from decisions of the board, and for the burden of 29 proof upon such appeals; prescribing penalties, fines and 30 imprisonment for violations of this act and rules, 31 regulations and orders of the board; defining perjury; 32 defining remedies; repealing legislation supplied and superseded by this act, and saving rights, duties and 33 proceedings thereunder; and making appropriations," 34

- 1 authorizing any school to purchase milk and milk products
- 2 from the lowest responsible bidder.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Section 301, act of April 28, 1937 (P.L.417,
- 6 No.105), known as the "Milk Marketing Law," amended July 31,
- 7 1968 (P.L.963, No.294), is amended to read:
- 8 Section 301. Regulation of Milk Industry. -- The board is
- 9 hereby declared to be the instrumentality of the Commonwealth
- 10 for the purpose of administering the provisions of this act and
- 11 to execute the legislative intent herein expressed, and it is
- 12 hereby vested with power to supervise, investigate and regulate
- 13 the entire milk industry of this Commonwealth, including the
- 14 production, transportation, disposal, manufacture, processing,
- 15 storage, distribution, delivery, handling, bailment, brokerage,
- 16 consignment, purchase and sale of milk and milk products in this
- 17 Commonwealth, and including the establishment of reasonable
- 18 trade practices, systems of production control and marketing
- 19 area committees in connection therewith: Provided, however, That
- 20 nothing contained in this act shall be construed to alter, amend
- 21 or repeal any of the laws of this Commonwealth relating to the
- 22 regulation of public utilities, or to the public health or to
- 23 the prevention of fraud and deception, except as herein
- 24 otherwise specifically provided: And provided further, That
- 25 nothing in this act shall be construed to prohibit any school
- 26 from purchasing milk or milk products from the lowest
- 27 responsible bidder.
- 28 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
