AN ACT

1 Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), entitled
2 "An act concerning elections, including general, municipal,
3 special and primary elections, the nomination of candidates,
4 primary and election expenses and election contests; creating
5 and defining membership of county boards of elections;
6 imposing duties upon the Secretary of the Commonwealth,
7 courts, county boards of elections, county commissioners;
8 imposing penalties for violation of the act, and codifying,
9 revising and consolidating the laws relating thereto; and
10 repealing certain acts and parts of acts relating to
11 elections," providing for State reimbursement of counties for
12 ballots cast at the primary and general elections in even-
13 numbered years.

14 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
15 hereby enacts as follows:

16 Section 1. The act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), known
17 as the "Pennsylvania Election Code," is amended by adding a
18 section to read:

19 Section 1012. State Reimbursement for Ballots Cast.--The
20 Commonwealth shall reimburse each county in the amount of
21 seventy-five cents (75¢) for each ballot cast at the primary and
22 general elections conducted in even-numbered years. The county
23 board of elections of each county shall certify to the Secretary

- 1 of State after each such primary and general election the number
- 2 of ballots cast thereat.
