AN ACT

1 Repealing clause (5) of subsection (e) of section 208, act of
2 May 17, 1921 (P.L.789, No.285), entitled, as amended, "An act
3 relating to insurance; establishing an insurance department;
4 and amending, revising, and consolidating the law relating to
5 the licensing, qualification, regulation, examination,
6 suspension, and dissolution of insurance companies, Lloyds
7 associations, reciprocal and inter-insurance exchanges, and
8 certain societies and orders, the examination and regulation
9 of fire insurance rating bureaus, and the licensing and
10 regulation of insurance agents and brokers; the service of
11 legal process upon foreign insurance companies, associations
12 or exchanges; providing penalties, and repealing existing
13 laws," deleting the provision relating to nonapplicability of
14 section 208 to transactions in this Commonwealth involving
15 group or blanket insurance or group annuities where the
16 master policy of such group was lawfully issued and delivered
17 in a state in which the company was authorized to do
18 insurance business.

19 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
20 hereby enacts as follows:

21 Section 1. Clause (5) of subsection (e) of section 208, act
22 of May 17, 1921 (P.L.789, No.285), known as "The Insurance
23 Department Act of one thousand nine hundred and twenty-one," is
24 repealed.

25 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
