AN ACT

- Repealing clause (5) of subsection (e) of section 208, act of 2 May 17, 1921 (P.L.789, No.285), entitled, as amended, "An act relating to insurance; establishing an insurance department; 3 and amending, revising, and consolidating the law relating to 4 5 the licensing, qualification, regulation, examination, suspension, and dissolution of insurance companies, Lloyds 7 associations, reciprocal and inter-insurance exchanges, and certain societies and orders, the examination and regulation 8 9 of fire insurance rating bureaus, and the licensing and regulation of insurance agents and brokers; the service of 10 legal process upon foreign insurance companies, associations 11 or exchanges; providing penalties, and repealing existing 12 13 laws," deleting the provision relating to nonapplicability of 14 section 208 to transactions in this Commonwealth involving 15 group or blanket insurance or group annuities where the master policy of such group was lawfully issued and delivered 16 17 in a state in which the company was authorized to do 18 insurance business.

- 20 hereby enacts as follows:
- 21 Section 1. Clause (5) of subsection (e) of section 208, act
- 22 of May 17, 1921 (P.L.789, No.285), known as "The Insurance
- 23 Department Act of one thousand nine hundred and twenty-one, " is
- 24 repealed.
- 25 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
