## AN ACT

1 2 3 4 5 6	Authorizing, pursuant to the authority granted to the Legislature by section 11 of Article I of the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, suit against the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania as a party defendant and permitting the joinder of the Commonwealth as a party defendant in certain cases.
7	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8	hereby enacts as follows:
9	Section 1. Pursuant to the authority granted to the
10	Legislature by section 11 of Article I of the Constitution of
11	the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, it is herein provided that
12	whenever any person sustains bodily injury, death or damage to
13	property caused by the negligence of any employee of the
14	Commonwealth of Pennsylvania while such employee was acting
15	within the scope of his employment suit may be brought against
16	the Commonwealth as a party defendant. Whenever any such person
17	sues the employee to recover damages therefor, the joinder of
18	the Commonwealth as a party defendant is hereby authorized. Such

actions shall be brought in the court of common pleas in any

county where similar actions at law are authorized to be brought

- 1 and trial by jury shall be as in all cases at common law. In any
- 2 such suit, the Commonwealth shall not plead governmental
- 3 immunity as a defense.
- 4 Section 2. Nothing contained herein shall be construed to
- 5 repeal or modify the act of June 2, 1915 (P.L.736, No.338),
- 6 known as "The Pennsylvania Workmen's Compensation Act."
- 7 Section 3. Clause (1) of subsection (a) of section 401, act
- 8 of July 31, 1970 (P.L.673, No.223), known as the "Appellate
- 9 Court Jurisdiction Act of 1970," is repealed in so far as such
- 10 clause relates to the provisions of this act.
- 11 Section 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
