## AN ACT

1 ~~Making an appropriation~~ AMENDING THE ACT OF JUNE 30, 1975 (NO.8- ←—  
2 A), ENTITLED "AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE EXPENSES OF THE  
3 EXECUTIVE, LEGISLATIVE AND JUDICIAL DEPARTMENTS OF THE  
4 COMMONWEALTH, THE PUBLIC DEBT AND FOR THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS FOR  
5 THE FISCAL PERIOD JULY 1, 1975 TO JUNE 30, 1976, AND FOR THE  
6 PAYMENT OF BILLS INCURRED AND REMAINING UNPAID AT THE CLOSE  
7 OF THE FISCAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1975," PROVIDING THAT  
8 THE APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AFFAIRS FOR  
9 HOUSING AND REDEVELOPMENT ASSISTANCE AND THE APPROPRIATION TO  
10 THE LEGISLATIVE DEPARTMENT SHALL NOT LAPSE; CHANGING CERTAIN  
11 APPROPRIATIONS TO THE GOVERNOR, THE PENNSYLVANIA COUNCIL ON  
12 THE ARTS, THE GOVERNOR'S COUNCIL ON DRUG AND ALCOHOL ABUSE,  
13 THE AUDITOR GENERAL, THE TREASURY DEPARTMENT, THE DEPARTMENT  
14 OF AGRICULTURE, THE DEPARTMENT OF BANKING, THE DEPARTMENT OF  
15 COMMERCE, THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AFFAIRS, THE DEPARTMENT  
16 OF EDUCATION, THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL RESOURCES, THE  
17 DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH, THE PENNSYLVANIA HISTORICAL AND MUSEUM  
18 COMMISSION, THE DEPARTMENT OF INSURANCE, THE DEPARTMENT OF  
19 JUSTICE, THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND INDUSTRY, THE DEPARTMENT  
20 OF MILITARY AFFAIRS, THE PENNSYLVANIA BOARD OF PROBATION AND  
21 PAROLE, THE DEPARTMENT OF PROPERTY AND SUPPLIES, THE  
22 DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WELFARE, THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE, THE  
23 DEPARTMENT OF STATE, THE PENNSYLVANIA STATE POLICE, THE STATE  
24 TAX EQUALIZATION BOARD, THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, TO  
25 THE MAJORITY AND MINORITY LEADERSHIP ACCOUNTS OF THE SENATE  
26 AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, AND TO THE MAJORITY AND  
27 MINORITY LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT ACCOUNTS OF THE HOUSE OF  
28 REPRESENTATIVES; CLARIFYING APPROPRIATIONS TO THE GENERAL  
29 ASSEMBLY; ADDING APPROPRIATIONS TO THE GOVERNOR FOR THE  
30 NATIONAL GOVERNOR'S CONFERENCE, to the Department of  
31 Community Affairs for housing and redevelopment assistance,  
32 TO THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE FOR THE COMMUNITY FACILITIES ←—  
33 PROGRAM, TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WELFARE FOR PAYMENTS TO

1 SECOND CLASS COUNTIES FOR COUNTY HOMES; REINSTATING AND  
2 REENACTING APPROPRIATIONS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WELFARE  
3 FOR CHILD WELFARE PROGRAMS AND THE FOOD STAMP PROGRAM, AND TO  
4 THE JUDICIAL DEPARTMENT FOR COUNTY REIMBURSEMENT FOR COURT  
5 COSTS; AND TRANSFERRING, REINSTATING AND REENACTING AN  
6 APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH FROM THE DEPARTMENT  
7 OF PUBLIC WELFARE FOR GRANTS TO COUNTY DEPARTMENTS OF HEALTH.

8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
9 hereby enacts as follows:

10 ~~Section 1. The sum of \$19,650,000, or as much thereof as may~~ <—  
11 ~~be necessary, is hereby specifically appropriated to the~~  
12 ~~Department of Community Affairs to be expended by making grants~~  
13 ~~for housing and redevelopment assistance as authorized by the~~  
14 ~~act of May 20, 1949 (P.L.1633, No.493), known as the "Housing~~  
15 ~~and Redevelopment Assistance Law," and by payment of the costs~~  
16 ~~of administering such act up to but not exceeding an amount~~  
17 ~~equalling 2% of this appropriation. No more than 20% of the~~  
18 ~~amount herein appropriated shall be allocated or granted to any~~  
19 ~~one political subdivision.~~

20 ~~Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1975.~~

8 REPRESENTATIVES; BY ADDING APPROPRIATIONS TO THE GOVERNOR FOR  
9 THE NATIONAL GOVERNOR'S CONFERENCE, TO THE DEPARTMENT OF  
10 COMMUNITY AFFAIRS FOR HOUSING AND REDEVELOPMENT ASSISTANCE, TO  
11 THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE FOR THE COMMUNITY FACILITIES PROGRAM,  
12 AND TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WELFARE FOR PAYMENTS TO SECOND  
13 CLASS COUNTIES FOR COUNTY HOMES; BY REINSTATING AND REENACTING  
14 APPROPRIATIONS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WELFARE FOR CHILD  
15 WELFARE PROGRAMS AND THE FOOD STAMP PROGRAM, AND TO THE JUDICIAL  
16 DEPARTMENT FOR COUNTY REIMBURSEMENT FOR COURT COSTS; AND BY  
17 TRANSFERRING, REINSTATING AND REENACTING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE  
18 DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WELFARE FOR  
19 GRANTS TO COUNTY DEPARTMENTS OF HEALTH TO READ:

20 SECTION 2. THE FOLLOWING SUMS, OR AS MUCH THEREOF AS MAY BE  
21 NECESSARY, ARE HEREBY SPECIFICALLY APPROPRIATED FROM THE GENERAL  
22 FUND TO THE SEVERAL HEREINAFTER NAMED AGENCIES OF THE EXECUTIVE,  
23 LEGISLATIVE AND JUDICIAL DEPARTMENTS OF THE COMMONWEALTH FOR THE  
24 PAYMENT OF THE SALARIES, WAGES OR OTHER COMPENSATION AND TRAVEL  
25 EXPENSE OF THE DULY ELECTED OR APPOINTED OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES  
26 OF THE COMMONWEALTH, FOR PAYMENT OF FEES OF CONTRACTUAL SERVICES  
27 RENDERED, FOR THE PURCHASE OR RENTAL OF GOODS, SERVICES,  
28 PRINTING, EQUIPMENT, LAND AND BUILDINGS AND FOR PAYMENT OF ANY  
29 OTHER EXPENSES, AS PROVIDED BY LAW OR BY THIS ACT, NECESSARY FOR  
30 THE PROPER CONDUCT OF THE DUTIES, FUNCTIONS AND ACTIVITIES AND

1 FOR THE PURPOSES HEREINAFTER SET FORTH FOR THE FISCAL PERIOD  
2 BEGINNING JULY 1, 1975 AND FOR THE PAYMENT OF BILLS INCURRED AND  
3 REMAINING UNPAID AT THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE  
4 30, 1975.
