1 ~~Making an appropriation~~ AMENDING THE ACT OF JUNE 30, 1975 (NO.8- <—
2 A), ENTITLED "AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE EXPENSES OF THE
3 EXECUTIVE, LEGISLATIVE AND JUDICIAL DEPARTMENTS OF THE
4 COMMONWEALTH, THE PUBLIC DEBT AND FOR THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS FOR
5 THE FISCAL PERIOD JULY 1, 1975 TO JUNE 30, 1976, AND FOR THE
6 PAYMENT OF BILLS INCURRED AND REMAINING UNPAID AT THE CLOSE
7 OF THE FISCAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1975," PROVIDING THAT
8 THE APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AFFAIRS FOR
9 HOUSING AND REDEVELOPMENT ASSISTANCE AND THE APPROPRIATION TO
10 THE LEGISLATIVE DEPARTMENT SHALL NOT LAPSE; CHANGING OR <—
11 AMENDING CERTAIN APPROPRIATIONS TO THE GOVERNOR, THE
12 PENNSYLVANIA COUNCIL ON THE ARTS, THE GOVERNOR'S COUNCIL ON
13 DRUG AND ALCOHOL ABUSE, THE AUDITOR GENERAL, THE TREASURY
14 DEPARTMENT, THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, THE DEPARTMENT OF
15 BANKING, THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE, THE DEPARTMENT OF

28 THE MAJORITY AND MINORITY LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT ACCOUNTS OF
29 THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES; CLARIFYING APPROPRIATIONS TO
30 THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY; ADDING APPROPRIATIONS TO THE GOVERNOR
31 FOR THE NATIONAL GOVERNOR'S CONFERENCE, to the Department of
32 Community Affairs for housing and redevelopment assistance,
33 TO THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE FOR THE COMMUNITY FACILITIES <—

1 PROGRAM, TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WELFARE FOR PAYMENTS TO
2 SECOND CLASS COUNTIES FOR COUNTY HOMES; REINSTATING AND
3 REENACTING APPROPRIATIONS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WELFARE
4 FOR CHILD WELFARE PROGRAMS AND THE FOOD STAMP PROGRAM, AND TO
5 THE JUDICIAL DEPARTMENT FOR COUNTY REIMBURSEMENT FOR COURT
6 COSTS; AND TRANSFERRING, REINSTATING AND REENACTING AN
7 APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH FROM THE DEPARTMENT
8 OF PUBLIC WELFARE FOR GRANTS TO COUNTY DEPARTMENTS OF HEALTH.

9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

10 hereby enacts as follows:

11 ~~Section 1. The sum of \$19,650,000, or as much thereof as may~~ <—
12 ~~be necessary, is hereby specifically appropriated to the~~
13 ~~Department of Community Affairs to be expended by making grants~~
14 ~~for housing and redevelopment assistance as authorized by the~~
15 ~~act of May 20, 1949 (P.L.1633, No.493), known as the "Housing~~
16 ~~and Redevelopment Assistance Law," and by payment of the costs~~
17 ~~of administering such act up to but not exceeding an amount~~
18 ~~equalling 2% of this appropriation. No more than 20% of the~~
19 ~~amount herein appropriated shall be allocated or granted to any~~
20 ~~one political subdivision.~~

21 ~~Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1975.~~

14 PAYMENTS TO SECOND CLASS COUNTIES FOR COUNTY HOMES; BY
15 REINSTATING AND REENACTING APPROPRIATIONS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF
16 PUBLIC WELFARE FOR CHILD WELFARE PROGRAMS AND THE FOOD STAMP
17 PROGRAM, AND TO THE JUDICIAL DEPARTMENT FOR COUNTY REIMBURSEMENT
18 FOR COURT COSTS; AND BY TRANSFERRING, REINSTATING AND REENACTING
19 AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH FROM THE DEPARTMENT
20 OF PUBLIC WELFARE FOR GRANTS TO COUNTY DEPARTMENTS OF HEALTH TO
21 READ:

22 SECTION 2. THE FOLLOWING SUMS, OR AS MUCH THEREOF AS MAY BE
23 NECESSARY, ARE HEREBY SPECIFICALLY APPROPRIATED FROM THE GENERAL
24 FUND TO THE SEVERAL HEREINAFTER NAMED AGENCIES OF THE EXECUTIVE,
25 LEGISLATIVE AND JUDICIAL DEPARTMENTS OF THE COMMONWEALTH FOR THE
26 PAYMENT OF THE SALARIES, WAGES OR OTHER COMPENSATION AND TRAVEL
27 EXPENSE OF THE DULY ELECTED OR APPOINTED OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES
28 OF THE COMMONWEALTH, FOR PAYMENT OF FEES OF CONTRACTUAL SERVICES
29 RENDERED, FOR THE PURCHASE OR RENTAL OF GOODS, SERVICES,
30 PRINTING, EQUIPMENT, LAND AND BUILDINGS AND FOR PAYMENT OF ANY

1 OTHER EXPENSES, AS PROVIDED BY LAW OR BY THIS ACT, NECESSARY FOR
2 THE PROPER CONDUCT OF THE DUTIES, FUNCTIONS AND ACTIVITIES AND
3 FOR THE PURPOSES HEREINAFTER SET FORTH FOR THE FISCAL PERIOD
4 BEGINNING JULY 1, 1975 AND FOR THE PAYMENT OF BILLS INCURRED AND
5 REMAINING UNPAID AT THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE
6 30, 1975.

17 FOR THE PAYMENT TO THE COUNTIES IN REIMBURSE-
18 MENT OF THE DIRECT COSTS INCURRED BY THE COUNTIES
19 IN THE ADMINISTRATION AND OPERATION OF ALL COURTS
20 ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO ARTICLE V, SECTION 1 OF
21 THE PENNSYLVANIA CONSTITUTION AND FOR OFFICES

23 UNCOMMITTED AND UNENCUMBERED AS OF JUNE 30, 1976 SHALL

25 (B) THE APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AFFAIRS
