A JOINT RESOLUTION

1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth  
2 of Pennsylvania, authorizing exemption from taxation of  
3 historical properties privately owned.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
5 hereby resolves as follows:

6 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of  
7 the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with  
8 the provisions of the eleventh article thereof:

9 That subsection (a) of section two, article eight of the  
10 Constitution be amended by adding a clause to read:

11 Section 2. Exemptions and Special Provisions.--(a) The  
12 General Assembly may by law exempt from taxation:
