- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for penalties as to
- 3 crimes committed with firearms.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 1103 of Title 18, act of November 25,
- 7 1970 (P.L.707, No.230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 8 Statutes, added December 6, 1972 (P.L.1482, No.334), is amended
- 9 to read:
- 10 § 1103. Sentence of imprisonment for felony.
- 11 (a) A person who has been convicted of a felony may be
- 12 sentenced to imprisonment as follows:
- 13 (1) In the case of a felony of the first degree, for a
- 14 term which shall be fixed by the court at not more than 20
- 15 years.
- 16 (2) In the case of a felony of the second degree, for a
- 17 term which shall be fixed by the court at not more than ten
- 18 years.

- 1 (3) In the case of a felony of the third degree, for a
- term which shall be fixed by the court at not more than seven
- 3 years.
- 4 (b) A person who has been convicted of any felony when armed
- 5 with a firearm shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum
- 6 sentence of two years and shall not be eligible for probation,
- 7 parole or any pre-release program outside of the institution to
- 8 which he was sentenced.
- 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
